ADMISSIONS POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Friends Community School is open to all regardless of race, color, national, or ethnic origin. We are particularly interested in accepting children of families who exhibit a sense of commitment to the child, the school, its projects, and the school community.

Complete application files are read by the Head, the Admissions Director, and grade level teachers. If the file indicates compatibility with the school, the prospective student spends time in the classroom and is evaluated on the basis of compatibility with the school's goals and expectations, as well as with skills appropriate for their age group. The evaluation becomes part of the admissions file.

Admissions decisions are made by the Head, in consultation with the Admissions Director and teachers, and are based on the results of the applications, teacher recommendations, student evaluations, and family interviews. Through the comprehensive admissions process, FCS strives to encourage significant racial, ethnic, religious, and economic diversity. Special consideration for admissions is given to applicants who are members of the Society of Friends, regular attendees of local Meetings, and those who are siblings of current or former FCS students.

The school reserves the right to deny admission to a child.

Admissions decisions and financial aid decisions are made independently.

FCS admits students of any race, color, national, and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. FCS does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, financial aid program, and athletic and other school-administered programs.
